- 3. <u>Correspondence</u>: GC/Co-Admin Nemeth advised that the NJIIF received correspondence from DOBI, which will be discussed further in the Chairman's report below.
- 4. <u>Finance Report</u>: CFO Calise advised that the monthly Multi Line and Workers Compensation Fund financials through 4/25/22, including assessments and claims payments, are in the meeting packets, including the latest investment report as of 4/25/22. Calise also advised that he has received payment of almost 100% of Members' 2022 assessments.

5. <u>Chairman's Report</u>: Chairman Tucci announced the NJIIF Standing Committee chairs and members for 2022. Chairman Tucci asked GC/Co-Admin Nemeth for an update on the NJIIF's response to DOBI's recent request. GC/Co-Admin Nemeth reported that in response to the NJIIF's correspondence to DOBI dated March 23, 2022, DOBI sent a letter dated April 11. Nemeth summarized the letter, including DOBI's directive that the NJIIF retain an additional actuary to review the NJIIF's case reserves and IBNR and report back by September 30, 2022. Nemeth advised that the search for actuaries is underway.

- 8. Loss Control Consultant Report (PMA) Tim Weir advised that Chris Brid has left PMA, and that John Matthews has joined the NJIIF Risk Control service team. Additionally, Weir reported that the latest edition of PMA's "Safety Seen" newsletter was recently sent for the month of April. Weir also announced PMA upcoming online training events: (1) Reducing the Risks of Work-Related Heat Illness; and (2) OSHA Top 10 Violations.
- 9. <u>TPA Report</u> (PMA) Jennifer Signs provided an update on aggregate WC claims received through 4/1/22, including the number of reported COVID cases. She advised that claims generally continue to be timely reported. Signs also advised that the NJIIF has a total of 359 reported COVID cases (36 in 2022, 137 in 2021 and 186 in 2020), with 76 related claim petitions filed to date.
