Nemeth reported that he had emailed a brief update to DOBI today with regard to the status of the NJIIF's 12/31/21 audit reports, with an indication that the NJIIF's goal is to have the reports and 2023 budget ready for introduction at its November meeting. Nemeth's email included notice to DOBI that the NJIIF would likely merge the WC and ML Funds effective 1/1/23. Chairman Tucci next introduced his plan for improvement of NJIIF member development efforts, including the addition of a Marketing Director/Co-Administrator. Tucci recommended that an RFP for that position be posted asap.

- h. <u>Member & Development Committee</u> (Kazmark) Commissioner Kazmark reported that the NJIIF is actively engaged in underwriting 3-4 potential additional members; Risk Manager J. Gallo advised that two of them are in advanced stages of review.
- 7. <u>Risk Manager's Report</u> (Polaris Galaxy). J. Gallo reported that all member 2023 renewal applications have been received and all submissions have been provided to the excess markets. Gallo further advised that it is likely that the excess policies for 2023 will be streamlined, with one policy covering all lines, simplifying claim reporting and premium payments. He also reported that he is seeking quotes from the excess markets for an additional \$5MM in coverage. Commissioner Konopada complimented J. Gallo on his service to the NJIIF members.
- 8. Loss Control Consultant Report (PMA) Tim Weir advised that the October "Safety Seen" newsletter provided information on Fire Prevention and Leaf Collection Safety, as well as a COVID update and information on upcoming webinars available through PMA. Weir also reported that PMA will host an OSHA recordkeeping webinar. Commissioner Konopada requested that PMA look into the cost benefit of lightening detection equipment. Commissioner Vieiro advised that she can provide information Asbury Park has obtained for such systems.
- 9. <u>TPA Report</u> (PMA) Jennifer Signs provided an update on aggregate WC claims received through 10/1/22, including the number of reported COVID cases. She advised that total incurred losses for 2022 are substantially lower than the 5 year average. She reported that claims generally continue to be timely reported. Signs further reported that the NJIIF has a total of 392 reported COVID cases with 90 related claim petitions filed to date.
